a. CDBG Grant

New Business:

a. New Trucks for the Utility Department

Mr. Cliff brought before the board the need for 3 new trucks for the utility department. All 3 are worn and have over 200,000 miles on them. Cliff has worked through the state contract to get the best prices he could find on trucks. The Utility department does have the funds available to purchase these trucks. The truck used to read meters is the first that needs to be replaced. Wilson County Motors has a Chevrolet Colorado on their lot now and if the board agrees to the purchase, we will

need to let them know as soon as possible. The Colorado will cost around \$25,292.00. The other 2 trucks needed are to replace older Ford 150s. Lonnie Cobb Ford in Henderson has some F150s on order and if we place an order for the 2 needed then we should be able to get them in April. The cost for the Ford F150s is \$34,207.00 each. Mr. Larry Crawford made a motion, seconded by Mr. Paul Fuller to approved the purchase of 3 new trucks for the utility department. All voted "Aye".
